Job Title: Community Health Worker

Position Terms: Part-time (15-20 hours per week)

Pay: \$20 per hour (\$25 after becoming a Certified Community Health Worker)

The Chariho Youth Task Force is a 501(c)3 nonprofit working primarily in Charlestown, Hopkinton, and Richmond, Rhode Island. Our mission is to educate, empower, and engage youth and adults in order to create a sense of community, promote wellness, and sustain opportunities for Chariho voices to be heard. We envision a society driven toward physical and mental well-being created through collaboration, education, and activism to promote a positive community climate.

Job Description:

The Community Health Worker will serve as a liaison between the Narragansett Tribe and greater Chariho community and the Chariho Youth Task Force to promote programs and resources to residents. The Community Health Worker will do the following:

- Partner with local residents to address COVID-19 and long-standing economic, social, health/mental health, and food insecurity needs
- Attend trainings and work toward Community Health Worker Certification
- Engage the community through an asset-based community development model
- Assist with youth programming for middle and high school students
- Assist with monthly grant reporting and attend coalition/partner meetings
- Work alongside Chariho Youth Task Force staff and volunteers with other projects as assigned

Additional Details:

- Position will have flexible working hours and will require some evenings and weekend work for certain events/projects
- Position is reliant on available grant funds
- Staff person will primarily work in the community with some remote work from home
