- Work with youth to develop and conduct programs/activities/initiatives that address their needs
- Link individual youth in need of health/ behavioral health or social services with the CHW or school supports
- Make connections and leverage resources to foster greater opportunities for youth enrichment, recreation, employment, self-discovery, skill acquisition, career planning
- Document youth narratives and data required for project evaluation
